The state of emergency in public health - extended until July 31, 2020, including, throughout the Republic of Moldova.

The entry on the territory of Moldova through the state border crossing points is forbidden to foreign citizens and stateless persons, until August 1, 2020, with the following exceptions:

- family members of Moldovan citizens;
- persons possessing a long-stay visa, a residence permit or an equivalent document issued by the authorities;
- persons travelling for professional reasons, proven by visa, residence permit or another equivalent document;
- members of diplomatic missions and consular offices accredited in the Republic of Moldova, e.g. international organizations/missions, as well as their family members or staff which can provide humanitarian aid;
- persons in transit, including those repatriated as a result of the granting of consular protection. The transit itinerary will be established by the General Inspectorate of Border Police;
- persons travelling for health and humanitarian reasons, including an accompanying person, when appropriate (with the presentation of confirmatory documents);
- cross-border workers;
- drivers and personnel serving the means of transport, who perform transportation of cargo, crews and service personnel of aircraft/ships and brigades and service personnel of train sets.

Persons crossing the state border on the way to enter the Republic of Moldova will:

- complete the epidemiological file;
- sign the declaration on his / her own responsibility to respect the self - isolation regime for a period of 14 days.

The following categories of persons are not obliged to comply with the self-isolation regime for a period of 14 days (if they do not show clinical signs of respiratory infection or fever):

- drivers and service personnel of cargo road vehicles and road vehicles for the transport of persons against payment, crews and service personnel of aircraft/ships and brigades and service personnel of train sets;
- persons travelling for health or humanitarian reasons, including the accompanying person, depending on the instance (with the presentation of confirmatory documents);
- pupils/students, enrolled in educational units/institutions from abroad, who have to take tests or exams at the end of the middle school / high school / higher education cycles;
- persons travelling for professional reasons, proven by visa, residence permit or other confirmatory documents;

- cross-border workers;
- members of diplomatic missions and consular offices accredited in the Republic of Moldova, e.g. international organizations/missions, as well as their family members or staff which can provide humanitarian aid;
- people in transit.
